

#### BROWN BAG BOOK STUDY CONTINUES "Being Mortal: Medicine and What Matters in the End" By Atul Gawande December 4th at 11am Tack Room

In his bestselling books, Atul Gawande, a practicing surgeon, fearlessly revealed has the struggles of his profession. Now he examines its ultimate limitations and failures – in his own practices as well as others' – as life draws to a close. And he discovers how we can do better. He follows a hospice nurse on her rounds, a geriatrician in his clinic, and reformers turning nursing homes upside down. He finds people who show us how to have the hard conversations and how to ensure we never sacrifice what people really care about.

Riveting, honest, and humane, *Being Mortal* shows that the ultimate goal is not a good death but a good life – all the way to the very end.
